

Musical and Non-Musical Theater Placement Auditions 2011-2012

Frequently Asked Questions

Since our inaugural year in 2004, we have observed the current theatrical talent base in the Tampa community, sought out feedback from parents, students and faculty and employed the assistance of national and international guilds and professional advisors. Over the past year, we have sculpted a streamlined track system in which actors can progress through a series of benchmarks and flow from the classroom into a rehearsal and back into the classroom for the next level of advancement. For our department to provide the student with the most ideal level of education we now require placement for every student.

Do I need to attend a placement audition every session?

Students will only need to attend one placement audition provided that they are continuously enrolled in the theater program and will receive placement recommendations at the end of each session. New students and those who have not attended within a year will require a placement audition.

What happens at placement auditions?

Acting (non-musical theater) students will take a sample class in theater for their placement audition. Students auditioning for Styles of Acting should additionally prepare a 1-minute monologue.

Musical theater students will take sample classes in dance, music and theater for their placement audition.

How long are the placement auditions?

A music placement audition takes 15 minutes. Dance and theater placement auditions take 45 minutes each.

What should I wear?

Each student should dress appropriately for their placement audition.

Is there a fee?

There is a \$15 placement audition fee for new or lapsed students. Students enrolled in Spring or Summer of 2011 (The Wiz, Alice in Wonderland, LOL: The Musical, or Seussical Jr.) will have their placement fee waived.
