## Fees:

Non Refundable Registration Fee: \$25

Non Refundable Production Fee for PCYT : \$75

## Payment Policies:

- Payment at time of registration must include registration fee and first month's tuition payment.
- Registration and production fee are not refundable or transferable. If the production fee is not paid by October 10, 2011 (for fall) or February 10, 2012 (for spring) and your child is still enrolled in the PCYT program, your credit card on file will be automatically charged for this fee. Production fee includes DVD of child's performance.
- School-year tuition payment options: students may choose between annual (payment in full) or monthly payments.
  - Annual Tuition Payment (payment in full at time of registration)
    - Multiply the month tuition by 8
    - Subtract 5% discount for paying in full
    - Add the \$25 registration fee
  - Monthly Payment
    - 8 payments from September-April
    - Paid by automatic pre-authorized debit from bank account or credit card
    - Add the \$25 registration fee to the first month tuition. First month tuition and \$25 registration fee, are due at the time of registration.
    - Monthly tuition is deducted on the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month before. For example, November's tuition is deducted on October 20<sup>th</sup>.
- Tuition is based on the total number of classes offered during the school year, taking into consideration holidays and a reduced class schedule in December. Classes begin during the week of September 6-9 and end during the week of May 14-19.
- Class tuition is non-refundable. There are no tuition credits. There are no refunds for missed classes and no discounts for partial class participation.
  - Students are encouraged to make up missed classes by taking an additional class in their level or the level below.
- In order to drop a class you will need to fill out a drop form and turn it in to the Chairman's Library. Once this form is filled out, the student will be dropped from the class and the monthly withdrawals will be stopped.
  - These forms are due by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month in order to ensure that you will not get charged your monthly tuition. (For example, November's tuition would be deducted on October 20, so the drop form would be due by October 10.)
- If a student is awarded Financial Aid, it does not apply to the production fee.

## Discounts and Incentives:

- **Maximum Family Registration Fee**
  - The registration fee of \$25 per student is now capped at a \$50 maximum registration fee, per family
  - Immediate family members include siblings, parents and grandparents. The maximum registration fee does not apply to extended family members or friends. Family members must be verified and approved through the Registrar's office prior to being eligible for the maximum registration fee offer.
- **Referral Program: Once Month Free Tuition for every student referred!**
  - For each student referred, one month's tuition will be waived from the final months' class(es). In order for the offer to be valid, both students must remain enrolled through the remainder of the school year.
  - Valid for school-year/academic classes only. School-year classes continue through May.
- **Pay in full and save 5%**
  - Students whose full session tuition is paid prior to the start of their first class will receive a 5% discount.
  - Valid for school-year/academic classes only. School-year classes continue through May.
